Accounts Receivables Benchmarks

- Total average of accounts receivables should reflect no more than the average of the last 3 months receipts
- Percentage of monies in aging buckets falls within the recommended ranges



Current	60-75%
31-60 Days	15-25%
61-90 Days	5-10%
91-120 Days	2-5%
120+ Days	1-2%



Month	Receipts Collected
July	\$78,948
August	\$62,349
September	\$85,243

Average = \$75,513



Check Benefits and Eligibility



Obtain Authorization, if applicable




Create Invoice/Fee Slip/Routing Slip



Self-Pay Patient



Patient with Third-Party Payor



Patient Accounts Receivables and Collections





Collect Copay, Deductible, Coinsurance



Collect Balance Due on any non-covered services/materials



Claims submission, Review and post Remittance Advice from Third-Party Payor



Send Bill to Patient for any remaining balances not collected on the date of service

- Insurance rejections and denials

- Lack of Accountability
- To send or not send Collections Agency



Accounts Receivables Management Strategy


- Review your Accounts Receivables
